Trade Programme - Components

- **Sector project: Trade Policy, Promotion of Trade and Investment**
 - Aid for Trade
 - Economic Partnership Agreements (EPAs)
 - Trade in Services
 - Foreign Direct Investment
 - Intellectual Property rights (especially related to pharmaceuticals)
- **Sector project: Agricultural Trade**
 - Monitoring of multilateral and bilateral Agricultural Trade negotiations (WTO, EPAs)
 - Monitoring of EU-Common Agricultural Policy, in collaboration with the „European Network on Agriculture, Trade and Development“
 - Regional Agricultural Trade (Market information systems, regional transport, quality)
 - Food quality and food safety; Policy advice and training-on-the-job (e.g. Novel Food Regulation; SPS/TBT Enquiry Points; local certification bodies, group certification)
 - Networking: Standards and Trade Development Facility (STDF), Trade Standards Practitioners Network (TSPN), Biotrade Facilitation Programme (UNCTAD + IFC)

Trade Programme - Components

- **Monterrey Fund**
 - Trade-related assistance is not a separate priority area in German development cooperation, but part of other sectors (particularly sustainable economic development; food security and agriculture; environmental policy, conservation and sustainable use of natural resources; and democracy, civil society and public administration).
 - Therefore, the Monterrey Fund plays a key role
 - in the mainstreaming of trade-related assistance
 - in the development of innovative instruments and expertise and
 - in the integration of trade-related aid into the approaches and instruments of German development cooperation

Trade Programme - Cooperation

Aim

- Develop innovative approaches for trade and investment promotion
- Improve the promotion and support of trade related concepts, methods, instruments in developing countries
- Contribute for a better integration of results in existing programmes and projects of the BMZ and in Partner Countries

Outputs

- Cooperate with other donors' initiatives (CBTF, BTFFP)
- Support networks for capacity building (Network of – preferably local - experts on SPS, GI, ABS etc. capable of advising political decision-makers on biotrade issues)
- Planning and implementation of innovative trade and investment approaches in pilot projects (Peru, Namibia, Nepal in a view to reach the respective regions)
- Mainstreaming of trade and investment approaches (replication of good practices within the region or across regions, good practice examples used as input for multilateral negotiations)
- Carry out trade related training (training based on documented experience that becomes public shareware)
- Implement the Aid for Trade strategy (improved regulatory environment and trade development)
