Assessment of policy responses 1

Projected effect on wildlife trade (and wider conservation impact)	Coherence with international conservation and development commitments
Level of complexity	Feasibility
Cost of implementation and operation	Institutional capacity to implement
Social impact	Powerful opposition/ ease of introduction
Economic impact	Other factors of interest and concern

Assessment of policy responses 2

Additional options:

- SWOT of a given measure
- Panel judgements of different options

Comparative analysis of different scenarios
Draft conclusions & recommendations
2nd National Stakeholder Workshop & local sessions (feedback sessions)
