## COMPOSITION OF THE RSTWG

- ◆ Composed of a cross - section of stakeholders
- ◆ 5 representatives from NBSs Kenya, Tanzania, Uganda Rwanda and Burundi.
- ◆ 3 from certification bodies,
- ◆ 3 from NOAMs
- ◆ 1 from the East African Business Council.

## Role of RSTWG

- ◆ Lead in developing East African Organic Standards.
- ◆ Provide technical inputs in the drafting
  - Two drafts produced so far.

## Work done

- ◆ **Establishment of the RSTWG**
- ◆ **Framework of the standard.**
- ◆ **1<sup>st</sup> RSTWG meeting - Oct 05 to compare stds**
- ◆ **Drafting Standards - inputs from 2<sup>nd</sup> RSTWG meeting in March 06**
- ◆ **National consultative meetings for comments in May 06**

## cont

- ◆ **3<sup>rd</sup> RSTWG meeting in May to comment on the 1<sup>st</sup> Draft.**
- ◆ **Wider Stakeholders consultation - 2<sup>nd</sup> Draft**
- ◆ **National consultative meetings in September.**
- ◆ **Field Testing in Nov 27- Dec 1 2006**
- ◆ **"International" Forum Dec 2006.**
- ◆ **Comparison with International std (Codex & IFOAM)**

## Further Work

- ◆ **4<sup>th</sup> RSTWG to work for 3<sup>rd</sup> DRAFT to be ready by mid January 2007**
- ◆ **Submit Standard document to the Committee responsible for standards in the EAC**

### Cont.

- ◆ Adoption expected by April 06 by EAC council.
- ◆ Regional stds Launch planned end of May in TZ

### Ownership

- ◆ The East African Community (EAC)
- ◆ Stakeholders be fully involved during revisions - is our concern.
